This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of directions to official respondents not to unnecessarily harass the petitioner at the instance of private respondents with further directions to Investigating Agency not to conduct multiple inquiries in the same matter which has already been inquired into.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation on 20.11.2021 to respondent No.3- Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/12, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion restricted to respondents No.1 to 6 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Anmol Singh Sandhu, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 6. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into and decide representation dated 20.11.2021 (Annexure P/12) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within eight weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
