Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though the present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.239 dated 01.10.2021 registered under Sections 342, 323, 506 and 120-B of the IPC at Police Station Sadar, Amritsar, the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage in case a direction is issued to Commissioner of Police, Amritsar to decide their representation dated 22.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State very fairly submits that though the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar is not a party to the present petition but the State has no objection for deciding the representation of the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State submits that appropriate order on the representation dated 22.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) filed by the petitioners, will be passed by the Commissioner of Police, Amritsar within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the undertaking of the learned State counsel, the petitioners do not wish to press this petition any further, at this stage and the same may kindly be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.

It will be appreciated that before passing the order on the representation, all the persons, who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the representation, are heard.
