Through this petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.33 dated 06.04.2021, registered at Police Station Sadar Moga, District Moga, under Section 22 NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that recovery of 800 gram of heroin had allegedly been effected from a car, which is not owned by the petitioner; that there are allegations against the petitioner that he was driving the said car, and that the petitioner has sought information with regard to the call details of phones of his family members and the police officials, which has not been received by him so far.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one, once the petitioner has received the information with regard to the call details of phones of his family members and the police officials.
