The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.213, dated 22.03.2021, registered under Sections 148, 149, 186, 223, 225, 332, 353, 379-B and 506 of the Indian Penal Code (Sections 201, 427 and 34 IPC added later and Sections 148, 149, 223 of IPC deleted later on), at Police Station Rai, District Sonapat.

2. The petitioner has remained in detention in the present case for more than 8 months since 31.03.2021.

3. Challan against him has already been filed after completion of investigation.

8. The trial is in progress and is likely to take some time. The affected victim in the present case happens to be a Police Officer, who therefore cannot be considered as vulnerable to any kind of pressure or threat at the instance of the petitioner if released on bail. Therefore, his

prayer for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
