The present petition has been filed for grant of regular bail to the petitioners in case bearing FIR No.31, dated 16.01.2021, registered under Section 379-A of IPC at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the complainant has already been examined and therefore, no useful purpose will be achieved in keeping the petitioners behind the bars during the entire period of trial and hence, the petitioners may be granted the concession of regular bail.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Rampal, submits that actual victim is Parul, whose bag is said to have been snatched by the petitioners, who is yet to be examined and the next date fixed before the trial Court is 24.12.2021.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the trial Court be bound to record the statement of the said victim positively either on 24.12.2021 or within a period of two weeks thereafter, so that, the petitioners can avail the concession of regular bail, in case found entitled for.

Keeping in view the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court that the victim Parul be examined either on the date already fixed before the trial Court, i.e. 24.12.2021 or within a period of two weeks thereafter so that, the petitioners, if entitled to, are considered for the grant of regular bail.
