The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to pay deficient amount worth ₹ 61,670/- along with interest @ 12% p.a. with effect from 06.09.2016, with a further prayer to fix responsibility for causing unnecessary embarrassment to the petitioner by abuse of power in retaining and using the amount with malafide intention for more than five years, as well as to decide the legal notice dated 12.10.2021 (Annexure P-2).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the respondents to consider legal notice dated 12.10.2021 (Annexure P-2) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in

accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
