Prayer in this writ petition is for issuance of a writ of mandamus directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for grant of emergency parole in the light of the death of his grandmother on 27.11.2021 and to attend the last rites and the ceremonies which are fixed for 10.12.2021.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner had drafted an application for grant of emergency parole but the same has not been received by The Superintendent, District Jail, Rohtak. True translated copy of the said representation/application dated 28.11.2021 has been appended as Annexure P-1. He asserts that the Gram Panchayat has also stated that there are no chances of any disturbance nor is there any threat to the peace and security of the villagers from the petitioner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Raman Sharma, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Without going into the merits of the case or commenting thereon, we dispose of the present writ petition with directions to the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for grant of emergency parole and take a decision on the representation dated 28.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) which has been appended along with the present writ petition and decide the same within a period of three days from today. The decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
