The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant provisional pension, gratuity, retiral benefits to the petitioner and the provisional pay benefits for the period of suspension from 02.05.2017 to 14.09.2017 alongwith interest @ 18% per annum, for which, a legal notice dated 29.09.2021 (Annexure P-1) has also been served upon the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider the legal notice dated 29.09.2021 (Annexure P-1) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of receipt of copy of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay.
