The case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition under section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 47 dated 29.05.2019 under Sections 379, 34, Indian Penal Code, 1860 registered at Police Station GRP, District Hisar.

Vide order dated 18.09.2019 passed by Co-ordinate Bench of this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

It has been pointed out by learned counsel for the petitioner that the allegation of stealing is against the co-accused, Jai Singh @ Singhar and not against the petitioner. The petitioner was granted interim bail vide order dated 18.09.2019.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI-Rajinder, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation. He further states that the recovery is yet to be effected.

Since, there is no allegation of stealing/ theft against the petitioner, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 18.09.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 482(2), of the Criminal Procedure Code.
