The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to count qualifying service of husband of the petitioner for grant of revised family pension and other pensionary benefits w.e.f. the date of his joining the Corporation along with interest @ 18% p.a. on the delayed payments, as well as to decide the legal notice dated 24.09.2021 (Annexure P-6).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the respondents to consider legal notice dated 24.09.2021 (Annexure P-6) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a

period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
