GURVINDER SINGH GILL, J. (Oral)

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to surrender before the trial Court and to move an application for grant of regular bail while explaining his genuine reason that it was on account of wrong impression regarding date that he could not cause appearance on the date fixed.

In view of the aforesaid submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

Although the next date fixed before the trial Court is 22.12.2021, but the petitioner shall appear before the trial Court within a week from today and move an application for grant of regular bail, which shall be disposed of by the trial Court in accordance with the observations made in concluding paragraph of judgment passed

by this Court in CRM-M-39172 of 2021 titled Pawan Kumar Vs. State of Haryana & another decided on 21.09.2021 and also while considering all the contentions made on behalf of the petitioner regarding the cause of not being able to appear on the date fixed.
