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This case has been taken up in National Lok Adalat through
video conferencing on account of Covid-19 pandemic.

The matter has been amicably settled between the parties. It
has been settled that respondent No.3-Insurance Company shall pay a sum
of ₹3,70,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal to the
appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Out of the
enhanced amount, Rs. 35,000/- each shall be paid to appellant Nos. 5 and 6
i.e. the parents and balance amount shall be apportioned equally amongst
appellant Nos. 1 to 4.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance
Company to deposit the crossed-cheques in the name of the appellants with
the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 12.10.2021, in
compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall
follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The
concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper
receipt after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of
the respondent-Insurance Company. The share pertaining to the minors
shall be deposited in a fixed deposit in a nationalized Bank to be payable to

them at attaining the age of majority and no financial liability shall be permissible on the aforesaid FDRs.

The appellants(s) counsel/appellants may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
