Through the present petition the petitioner seeks issuance of a writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* for the release of Verinder Kumar Beri, who is alleged to be illegally detained by respondent No.4-Jekera Sheikh.

In response to the notice issued by this Court, an affidavit of Mr. K. K. Rao, IPS, Commissioner of Police, Gurugram, has been filed, in paragraph 4 of which it has been stated that Virender Kumar Beri, aged 89 years, when contacted by the police, made a statement that he has three children which include the petitioner and that the petitioner and one of his daughters namely Sunita Jassal have not visited him for the last ten years. He further stated that his other daughter namely Madhu Vadhera has also not visited him since long and that since his children have neglected him, he has formally disowned them. He still further stated that respondent No.4 - Zakira Sheikh wife of Irshad Sheikh is looking after him and that he is happy in her care.

The factum of disowning of his children as his legal heirs/successors by Virender Kumar Beri has also been verified by the Estate Manager, Princeton Estate, DLF Phase-V, Gurugram (Annexure R-1) and a notice in this regard which was got published by Virender Kumar Beri in a newspaper has also been attached with the Commissioner's affidavit as Annexure R-2.

In view of the above, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.
