This is an application for preponing the main case on the ground that the matter stands settled between the parties.

In this regard, a copy of the letter written by learned counsel for the appellant has been annexed as Annexure A-1 which clearly states that the proposal for settlement offered by the applicant-respondent no.3 (Insurance Company) is acceptable to the claimant-appellant.

Mr. Jaideep Verma, Advocate, learned counsel for the claimant-appellant, states that the matter has been settled between the parties and the applicant-respondent no.3 (Insurance Company) has agreed to deposit a sum of Rs.2,75,000/- over and above the amount ordered by the Tribunal towards full and final settlement of the award. He further states that a cheque dated 29.03.2021 for Rs.2,75,000/-, copy appended as Annexure A-2, has been issued by the applicant-respondent no.3 (Insurance Company) though the

same has not been handed over to him till date. However, both the counsel are *ad idem* that the matter stands settled.

In view of the above and with the consent of the learned counsel for the parties, the date fixed in the main appeal is preponed and the matter is taken on board today itself.

Application stands disposed off.

FAO-3030-2018

Learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the parties have since settled the matter and respondent no.3-Insurance Company has agreed to pay an amount of Rs.2,75,000/- over and above the amount ordered by the Tribunal towards full and final settlement of the award, which is acceptable to the claimant-appellant.

In view of the above, the present appeal is disposed off as having been settled between the claimant-appellant and respondent no.3-Insurance Company. Respondent no.3-Insurance Company shall hand over the cheque for Rs.2,75,000/- to learned counsel for the appellant within a period of one week from today.

Disposed off accordingly.
