As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants, learned counsel and representative of the respondent-Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs. 3,50,000/- (Rs. Three lakh and fifty thousand) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant Nos.1, 4 and 5, out of which an amount of Rs.2,80,000/- to be paid to appellant No.1, widow of the deceased and Rs.70,000/- to be paid to appellant Nos.4 & 5, parents of the deceased, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant Nos.1, 4 and 5 in proportion to the amount awarded by MACT.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit two separate crossed-cheques to be deposited in the sum of Rs.2,80,000/- in the name of appellant No.1 and the remaining amount of Rs.70,000/- in the name of appellant Nos.4 and 5, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within a period of four weeks from today, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok

Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
