The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of habeas corpus directing the respondent Nos. 4 and 5, who are stated to be the parents of the detenue to produce the detenue.

Learned State counsel as well as learned counsel for respondent No. 4 has submitted that in the present case, the statement of the detenue has been recorded before the Sub Divisional Judicial Magistrate, Abohar and as per the said statement, the detenue wishes to reside with respondent Nos. 4 and 5 and her family members out of her free will and without pressure.

In view of the same, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition to seek alternate remedy in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
