The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to correctly fix the family pension of the petitioner by giving periodic enhancement under Rules and consequently pay entire arrears along with compound interest @ 18% p.a. as well as to decide the representation dated 10.07.2019 (Annexure P-5) and the legal notice dated 04.09.2021 (Annexure P9).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the respondents to consider representation dated 10.07.2019 (Annexure P-5) and the legal notice dated 04.09.2021 (Annexure P9) and

decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
