The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 and 2 to conduct a fair and impartial enquiry into the alleged selections being made by the president of respondent number 3 Society which are in total violation to the Punjab State Cooperative Agricultural Service Societies Rules, 1997 as well as to decide the representation dated 23.09.2021 (Annexure P-4).
