The petitioner is aggrieved because she has been declared 'failed' in the Senior Secondary School Examination.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the Senior Secondary School Examination was not held, result was calculated on the basis of formula of 30:40:40. The petitioner would have passed even if her Class X and Class XI results only were considered.

The Senior Secondary School Examination result is on record as Annexure P-3. The same shows that the petitioner was absent for 04 papers out of a total of 09 papers. In one she has failed. Thus, the petitioner has failed in 05 out of 09 subjects. Obviously, having not qualified in the Class XII examination, she has not been considered eligible for declaration of result on the basis of 30:40:40 formula.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has failed to show that the non-consideration of the petitioner was contrary to the policy framed for declaration of result.

Thus, the writ petition has no merit and is dismissed.
