The instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 9. Prayer has also been made to look into the complaints submitted by petitioner No.1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner, at the very outset, submits that for their grievance, petitioner No.1 has already submitted complaints dated 19.10.2021 and 30.10.2021 (Annexures P-5 & P-6 respectively) to the Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Ludhiana i.e. Respondent No.2 herein, but no action has been taken thereon so far. The petitioners would be satisfied in case the said complaints be decided in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only at this stage.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. A.S.Gill, Senior DAG, Punjab, has put in appearance through the medium of video conferencing and accepts notice on behalf of official respondents and submits that the official respondents will look into the matter and will take a decision on the complaints submitted by petitioner No.1.

Let sufficient number of copies of the complete paper book be supplied to her during the course of day.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Ludhiana, to take a decision on the complaints dated 19.10.2021 and 30.10.2021 (Annexures P-5 & P-6 respectively) submitted by petitioner No.1, within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
