Petitioner, who is serving as Physical Training Instructor (P.T.I) with the respondent-department, has filed this writ petition for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents:-

- (a) to grant the 2nd Assured Career Progression (ACP) to the petitioner, which is stated to have become due to the petitioner w.e.f., November 2020 along with arrears with interest at the rate of 12% per annum;
- (b) to enter the 'confirmation' remarks in the service book of the petitioner and complete the service book;
- (c) to grant permission to the petitioner to go abroad i.e., Canada from 2nd June 2022 to 29th June 2022, to enable the petitioner to attend the annual Convocation of his daughter who is studying in Coquitlam College, Canada.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State to whom an advance copy of the writ petition has been supplied was asked to seek instructions in respect to the prayers addressed in this writ petition.

The matter has been taken up again in the post-lunch session.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State, has circulated a copy of communication dated 06.12.2021, from the District Elementary Education

Officer, Panipat addressed to the learned Advocate General, Haryana, Chandigarh, wherein it is stated that all ACP cases in the State are pending due to a technical issue and the same shall be resolved as soon as possible and that instructions have been issued to Disbursing and Drawing Officer for completion of service book of the petitioner. It is further stated that the case regarding permission to the petitioner for going abroad has not been received and the same shall be sent to the Director Elementary Education for approval on priority basis on receipt. Photocopy of communication dated 06.12.2021 be attached with this petition.

Keeping in view the factual position as above, no interference is called for, at this stage. However, competent authority is directed to finally decide petitioner's request for going abroad expeditiously and preferably within a period of two months from receipt of certified copy of this order subject to submission of all relevant papers by the petitioner. It is clarified that there is no expression of opinion on the merits of the case.

Writ petition is accordingly disposed of.
