MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

This is the first petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.520 dated 21.09.2021 lodged under Sections 498-A, 406, 506 and 377 IPC (added lateron) registered at Police Station Sampla, District Rohtak.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that it was on account of a marital discord between the complainant and her husband that the FIR in question came to be registered, however, subsequently the parties arrived at an amicable settlement. Thereafter, both the parties approached this Court by way of CRM-M-54160-2021 for quashing of the FIR in question in which this Court while issuing notice had directed the parties to get their respective statements recorded qua the compromise arrived at before the trial Court. Learned counsel submits that in the wake of the aforementioned facts and circumstances further incarceration of the petitioner would serve no

useful purpose as he has now been in custody since 14.10.2021.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the factum of the parties having approached this Court by way of CRM-M-54160-2021 for quashing of the FIR in question on the basis of a compromise.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material placed on record.

In view of the facts and circumstances as enumerated hereinabove, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned. However, it is made clear that anything observed hereinabove shall not be construed to be an expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
