The present petition filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 (for short 'the Cr.P.C.') is for seeking directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to present final report under Section 173 of the Cr.P.C. before learned trial Court in case FIR No. 83 dated 18.05.2020 registered under Sections 341, 323, 356, 506, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Anaj Mandi Patiala, District Patiala.

On the previous date i.e. 06.12.2021 learned State Counsel was directed to file reply by way of an affidavit to the effect that on which date report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. has been filed.

In compliance to the aforesaid order, short reply by way of affidavit of Mohit Kumar Aggarwal, PPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, City-2, Patiala has been filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 today.

In para No. 4 of the reply, it has been duly mentioned that on completion of the investigation two reports under Section 173 of the Cr.P.C. were prepared on 17.07.2021 and after securitization, final report under Section 173 of the Cr.P.C. was presented before the learned trial Court on 11.08.2021 and charges against both the parties have been framed.

In view of the averments made in the reply/affidavit referred to above, the present petition seeking directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to present final report under Section 173 of the Cr.P.C. before the learned trial Court has become infructuous and the same is disposed of as having become infructuous.
