The petitioners have invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to release the amount of FDRs (Annexures P5 to P19) of the petitioners and amount lying in their saving account along with interest upto date as well as to decide their representations dated 16.06.2020 and 20.08.2021 (Annexures P-20 and P21).

Heard.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Ms. Anju Arora, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to her.

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the representations dated 16.06.2020 and 20.08.2021 (Annexures P-20 and P21) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioners without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
