Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C raising a grievance that proper investigation in FIR No. 197 dated 09.07.2021 registered under Sections 147, 148, 149, 307, 341, 395 IPC and Section 25, 54 and 59 of the Arms Act at Police Station Siwani, District Bhiwani against the private respondents, is not being done in a proper manner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that not only the relevant Sections have been deleted from the FIR but no action is being taken against the accused. The prayer of the petitioner is for issuance of the directions to the investigating agency to conduct free and fair investigation in FIR No. 197 dated 09.07.2021. He further submits that with regard to the grievance, which has been raised in the present petition, the petitioners have already filed a complaint dated 09.10.2021 (Anenxure P-5) with the SSP, Bhiwani i.e. Respondent No. 3 and the petitioners will be satisfied at this stage in case a time bound direction is

given to respondent No. 3 to decide the said complaint by passing an appropriate order.

Notice of motion

Mr. Gaurav Bansal, AAG, Haryana, who has joined the proceedings, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned State counsel raises no objection in decision of the representation dated 09.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) by respondent No. 3 in a time bound manner.

Without making any observation on the merits of the case or with regard to the claim made by the petitioner in representation dated 09.10.2021 (Annexure P-5), a direction is issued to respondent No. 3 to take appropriate decision on the representation, which the petitioner alleged to have made on 09.10.2021 (Annexure P-5) by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.

It will be appreciated if all the persons who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the decision, are heard before the passing of the same.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
