FATEH DEEP SINGH, J.

The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to count the entire daily wage/work charge services of the petitioners rendered before regularization as qualifying service for the purposes of pay fixation, proficiency step up, pensionary and retiral benefits in terms of orders of this Court (Annexure P1) as well as to decide the representation dated 15.10.2021 (Annexure P-2).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the representation dated 15.10.2021 (Annexure P2) and decide the same in accordance with law

by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
