By these petitions, the petitioners seek the concession of 'regular bail' under the provisions of Section 439 Cr.P.C., upon FIR No.57, dated 31.05.2021, having been registered at Police Station Kalanaur, District Gurdaspur, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under the provisions of Sections 304/201 of the IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioners relies upon the order passed by this court in the case of two of his co-accused on 14.12.2021 (in CRM-M-43109-2021 and CRM-M-42787-2021), whereby they had been admitted to bail after a similar period of custody, on the ground that with the report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. having already been submitted to the trial court and

looking at the nature of the offences even as per the affidavit of the DSP, there would be reason to keep them in custody any longer.

In view of the above, with the role of the petitioners not seeming to be any different from the said co-accused (Jatinder Pal alias Ajay Kumar and Akash alias Akash Masih), without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petitions are allowed and the petitioners are ordered to be admitted to bail, upon them furnishing adequate bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial court.
