The instant petition has been filed under Section 483 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.111 dated 03.08.2015, registered under Sections 420 and 34 IPC at P.S.Beas, District Amritsar Rural.

The allegation against the petitioner is that he induced the complainant to deliver Rs.12 Lakh on the pretext of sending the wife of the complainant to Italy and the complainant paid Rs.7 Lakh to the petitioner.

It is *inter alia* contended that the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Amritsar on 23.02.2016 but he could not appear before the trial Court on account of some unavoidable circumstances and resultantly, his bail bonds were cancelled and his arrest warrants were issued.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Tanvir Joshi, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent State.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that the date fixed before learned trial Court is 14.12.2021.

The ends of justice will be fully met if the petitioner is permitted to appear before learned trial Court and move fresh application for grant of regular bail, which will be decided by the trial Court on the very same day. However, learned trial Court would be at liberty to initiate proceedings under Section 446 Cr.P.C., if it so wishes.

Ordered accordingly.

Petition stands disposed of.
