The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant the Local Outdoor Duty Allowance (LODA) of ₹1800/- to the petitioner with effect from 07.04.2015 in stead of 04.07.2018 along with arrears for the period 2015 to 2018 in view of the enhancement made as well as to decide the representation dated 04.09.2015 (Annexure P-2).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the respondents to consider representation of the petitioner dated 04.09.2015 (Annexure P-2) and decide the same in accordance with

law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
