The case has been taken up in National Lok Adalat through video-conferencing due to COVID-19 pandemic.

The matter has been amicably settled between the parties. As per the statements recorded, it has been settled that the Insurance Company-respondent No.3 shall pay a sum of Rs.04,75,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the learned Motor Accident Claims Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

As per the settlement effected between the parties, respondent No.3-Insurance Company shall pay a sum of Rs.04,75,000/- over and above the amount which has already been awarded by the learned MACT. The amount shall be deposited within a period of 04 weeks before the learned MACT failing which respondent No.3-Insurance Company shall be liable to pay the enhanced amount of compensation with interest @ 9% per annum from the date of settlement before the Lok Adalat i.e. today.

Copy of this order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file by returned to the High Court. The enhanced amount shall be apportioned equally by both the appellants
