Allowed as prayed for. The appeal is taken on Board.

Main case

The claimants-appellants are in appeal seeking enhancement in the compensation of Rs.1,22,000/- as awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Yamunanagar at Jagadhari.

During the pendency of the appeal, a joint application (CM-1262-CII-2021) has been filed under Order 23 Rule 3 CPC for disposal of the appeal in terms of the compromise. This application is signed by the learned counsel representing the appellants as well as the Insurance Company. It is agreed that the claimants shall be paid an additional amount of Rs.1,00,000/-, over and above the amount awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, towards full and final settlement of their claim. The application is

supported by an affidavit.

Learned counsel representing the appellants submits that he has spoken to the appellants, taken their consent and signed the application.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this appeal is disposed of in terms of the application. The Insurance Company shall be liable to pay an additional sum of Rs.1,00,000/-, over and above the amount awarded by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal towards full and final settlement of the claim. The Insurance Company shall pay the amount of Rs.1,00,000/- by way of either a crossed cheque or a crossed draft drawn in favour of the appellants within a period of one month from today.

With these observations, the appeal is disposed of.
