The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to revise/re-fix his pay after restoration of his 3 No. of retrenchment increments in view of orders dated 27.05.2009 passed in CWP No.5568 of 2008 and requisite number of special increments with all consequential benefits of arrears thereof along with interest @ 12% p.a. and also to refund the recovered amount, if any, from his salary and other benefits along with statutory interest on delayed payment, with a further prayer to release actual benefits/arrears of ACP scheme including revision of pension, and also to count the past work charge service of the

petitioner rendered by him in Anandpur Sahib Hydel Project as qualifying service towards pensionary benefits as well as to decide the legal notice dated 15.09.2021 (Annexure P-2).

Heard.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Ms. Simran Grewal, Asst. Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to her.

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 15.09.2021 (Annexure P2) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
