ANUPINDER SINGH GREWAL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 37 dated 08.03.2021, under Sections 307, 324, 323 and 341 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Canal Colony Bathinda, District Bathinda.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the FIR is the outcome of a sudden quarrel between close relatives. The petitioner had given blows to the complainant with a stick and a screw driver. The petitioner is the brother-in-law of the complainant. With the intervention of the respectables, the matter has been compromised. A copy of the affidavit of the complainant is at Annexure P1. The injured has fully recovered from the injuries. The petitioner does not have criminal antecedents.

This Court, by the order dated 14.12.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Tara Singh, contends that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 14.12.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
