Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though number of prayers have been made in the present petition, but petitioners will be satisfied, at this stage, in case representation dated 28.10.2021 (Annexure P-22), which is stated to have been made to respondent No. 2 raising all the grievances, which are also part of the present petition, be decided in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Simsi Dhir Malhotra, learned A.P.P. U.T., Chandigarh, who is present in Court, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-U.T., Chandigarh. Learned counsel for U.T., Chandigarh raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 28.10.2021 (Annexure P-22) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioners, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation dated 28.10.2021 (Annexure P-22) by passing a speaking order within a period of three weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It will be appreciated that all the persons, who are likely to be affected by the outcome of the said representation, are heard before passing the speaking order.
