The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 117 dated 24.04.2021, under Section 307 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Section 27/54/59 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sector 6, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar.

Learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner contends that it is a case of accidental firing and the matter has been compromised. He also contends that the first petition of the petitioner for anticipatory bail was dismissed primarily on the ground that the pistol was to be recovered while the pistol was already in the police custody.

Heard.

It is alleged that the petitioner has caused a gunshot injury on the thigh of the complainant. The matter is later stated to have been compromised. The first petition of the petitioner bearing CRM-M No. 25205

of 2021 was dismissed by this Court on 11.10.2021 by noticing that the petitioner is accused of causing gunshot injury on the thigh of the complainant. I do not intend to take another view in the matter in the wake of the petitioner having allegedly caused a gunshot injury to the complainant.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.

However, it is clarified that nothing which has been observed here-in-above shall be deemed to have any bearing on the merits of the case.
