Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail in FIR No.128 dated 06.10.2021 under Section 61/1/14 of Excise Act, registered at Police Station Kiratpur Sahib, District Rupnagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per allegations in the FIR, the police party recovered 20 boxes of liquor meant for sale in Chandigarh. It is further submitted that the petitioner is in custody for the last more than 02 months; investigation is complete; offences are triable by the Court of Magistrate and he is no more required for custodial interrogation.

Learned State counsel, on the basis of custody certificate dated 14.12.2021 filed in the Court today, has not disputed the factual position.

Without commenting anything on merits of the case, considering

the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to be released on regular bail subject to furnishing his bail/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Illaq Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, concerned.

Petition is disposed of.
