On 9.12.,2021 when the case was taken up for hearing,
following order was passed : -

“ Learned counsel for the petitioner, with reference to para 16 of the writ petition, asserts that the appeal which has been preferred by the petitioner against the order dated 14.09.2020 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Director, Town and Country Planning, Directorate of Town and Country Planning, Haryana – respondent No.2 granting CLU to respondents No.6 to 8 for setting up an industrial unit (manufacturing of yarn from cotton) in the revenue estate of village Sithana is pending consideration from 08.11.2021, the date on which it was filed. The first date fixed for hearing was 12.11.2021 when the appeal was adjourned at the request of the counsel for the said respondents for 18.11.2021, where again the request was made and the appeal was rescheduled for 02.12.2021, on which date, because of the change in the administrative set-up, the officer

who was handling the appeal was no more the Secretary of the Department. No fresh date has been given for consideration of the appeal.
