This petition has been filed under Article 226 Constitution of India for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 for providing protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners, who apprehend danger at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that the petitioners fell in love with each other and developed relations, therefore, they decided to marry, but their proposal was opposed by the parents, brothers and other relatives of petitioner No.1 Kajal i.e. respondent Nos.3 to 8, as they wanted to marry her with a boy of their own choice. As a result of that, the petitioners performed marriage on 03.12.2021 at Prachin Pashupati Nath Shiv Mandir, Society, Booth No.228, MCD, Sector-4, Panchkula against the wishes of private respondents. After their marriage, the petitioners are receiving serious threats to their life and liberty from the parents of petitioner No.1 and in this regard, petitioners submitted a representation dated 05.12.2021 (Annexure P-3) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar. It is prayed that the petitioners be

provided protection.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by learned counsel that the parents of the girl have already given a complaint against petitioner No.2 Mustkeem and the argument that petitioner No.2 would be implicated in a false case cannot be construed as a threat to the life and liberty of the petitioners. The private respondents, who are parents and other relatives of petitioner No.1 are also free to avail their remedy in law in case, they feel that some offence has been committed against them.

Resultantly, no case is made out for invoking extra ordinary writ jurisdiction.

Dismissed.
