1. This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 139, dated 8th August, 2021, under Sections 307, 353, 186, 332, 323, 427, 506, 148 and 149 of IPC, 1860 and Section 3 and 4 of Prevention of Damage to Public Property Act, 1984, registered at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition. However, a request is made that the petitioner would surrender within ten days from today and apply for regular bail, his application be taken up expeditiously.

3. The petition is disposed of.

4. In case the petitioner surrenders within ten days from today and applies for regular bail, the court concerned shall take up the bail application within two days and decide it as expeditiously as possible.
