Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to pay salary of the petitioner during the time, he was illegally suspended w.e.f. 09.08.2017 to 14.02.2018 till reinstatement as the petitioner has been exonerated in the enquiry and further directing the respondents to release the benefit of ACP on completion of 14 years of service, w.e.f. 15.09.2012.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for petitioner, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case representation dated 06.10.2021 (P-8) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2- the Director Public Instruction (Secondary Education), Vidya Bhawan (Punjab School Education Board),

Phase-VIII, SAS Nagar (Mohali) to consider and decide the aforesaid representation in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
