The present petition has been filed with a prayer that keeping in view the complaint which the petitioner has been raped, a direction be issued to respondent No.2 for registration of an FIR and impartial investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the representation raising a grievance, as raised in the present petition, has already been submitted to respondent No.2 on 04.11.2021, which is still pending consideration, a copy of which has been appended as Annexure P-1. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 and 2 only.

Mr. Kirat Singh Sidhu, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 and 2. Learned State counsel raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 04.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) in a time bound manner.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner, respondent No. 2 is directed to decide the representation dated 04.11.2021 (Annexure P-1) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
