VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to the respondents to complete the enquiry/investigation with regard to alleged murder of Mohinder Singh son of the petitioner.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in the present case, complaint/application under Section 156(3) of Cr.P.C. dated 04.02.2020 had been filed before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib for registration of an FIR against the private respondents therein under Sections 302, 120-B and 201 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860. He has further submitted that in the said case, even the police report was called for on 04.02.2020 and thereafter another order was passed on 26.08.2021, in which, it was observed that Viscera report of deceased Mohinder @ Bhola was not received till the submission of the report on 05.03.2020 (actual date is 04.03.2020), accordingly, fresh report of SHO concerned was also called and it was observed that the report must be sent giving whole detail of every inquiry

conducted by the police in relation to the case alongwith Viscera report of the deceased and the case was adjourned to 07.10.2021. Further reference has also been made to order dated 22.11.2021 vide which fresh report of SHO concerned was not received and the case was adjourned to 18.01.2022.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner has argued that even the concerned police is not seriously complying with the orders passed by the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Notice of motion.

On advance notice, Mr. Sarabjit S. Cheema, AAG, Punjab, appears and accepts notice on behalf of the State and has submitted that he is fully prepared to argue the matter and assist this Court. He has submitted that they have highest regard for the judicial proceedings and they would comply with all the orders passed by the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib.

Keeping in view the abovesaid facts and circumstances, the present petition is disposed of with direction to the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib, before whom the application/complaint under Section 156(3) of Cr.P.C. is pending, to decide and conclude the same as expeditiously as possible and the respondent-State is also directed to comply with all the orders passed by the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate, Sri Muktsar Sahib so that the application/complaint under Section 156(3) of Cr.P.C. can be finally and expeditiously decided.
