Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to consider the petitioner under old pension scheme and he be given all the benefits under the same.

After arguing for some time, learned Counsel for petitioner, on instructions, states that instead of pressing the present petition on merits, his client would be satisfied in case legal notice dated 16.10.2021 (P-3) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion to the aforesaid limited extent.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.2- the Chief Engineer (HQ), PWD (B&R), Punjab to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice in accordance with law by passing speaking order within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
