The petitioners have invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant 2nd financial upgradation under the ACP Scheme to husband of petitioner No.1 from 25.03.2001 along with all consequential benefits including refixation of pay/pension, difference of salary, arrears and interest @ 18% p.a. with a further direction to the respondents to grant 3rd financial upgradation under the MACP Scheme to husband of petitioner No.1 from 25.03.2007 along with all consequential benefits including refixation of pay/pension, difference of salary, arrears and interest @ 18% p.a. as well as to decide the legal notice dated 06.10.2021 (Annexure P-10).

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 06.10.2021 (Annexure P10), as representation of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioners without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
