Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.64 dated 18.08.2021 under Sections 379-B, 323, 506, 34 IPC, registered at Police Station Ghuman Kalan, District Gurdaspur.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, submits that petitioner No.1 Jaskaran Singh stands arrested, therefore, this petition qua him be dismissed as withdrawn.

Ordered accordingly.

It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation against petitioner No.2 Daljit Singh and petitioner No.3 Arjun Singh and allegations are

against co-accused Channan Singh, who had a scuffle with complainant Amarjit Singh. It is also submitted that even the complainant had insulted sister-in-law of co-accused Channan Singh and in that process, the accused persons tried to forcibly put him in a car. The allegations of snatching the mobile phone are also against Chanan Singh and the same has already been recovered.

Learned State counsel could not dispute the fact that petitioners No.2 & 3 are first offenders and they are not involved in any other case.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, considering the aforesaid facts and circumstances of the case and also in view of the fact that main accused has already been arrested and recovery of mobile phone has also been effected, this petition qua petitioner No.2 Daljit Singh and petitioner No.3 Arjun Singh is allowed and they are granted the concession of anticipatory bail subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
