Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.77 dated 07.09.2019, under Sections 498-A, 406 and 120-B of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Rangar Nangal, District Gurdaspur.

Vide order dated 24.09.2019, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 24.09.2019, the petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his bail be confirmed.

Learned counsel for the complainant opposes the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh, affirmed that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 24.09.2019 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
