HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

Present petition has been filed seeking direction to respondents No. 1 and 2 as the petitioner apprehends threat to her life and liberty at the hands of the private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was maltreated and assaulted by her in-laws, on the basis of which, DDR No.58 dated 23.06.2021 was got registered at Police Station Gidderbaha, District Sri Muktsar Sahib but thereafter, no action has been taken so far on the same. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that as no action has been taken on the DDR mentioned above, same has resulted in issuance of threats by the private respondents to the petitioner, therefore, the

petitioner apprehends threat to her life and liberty. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance before the Senior Superintendent of Police, Sri Muktsar Sahib vide representation dated 06.09.2021 (Annexure P-3), which is still pending consideration with the said authority and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the said representation by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the respondent-State raises no objection in decision of the representation submitted by the petitioner by respondent No.2 in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Without commenting upon the merits of the case or about the entitlement of the petitioner for the relief which has been claimed by her in the representation dated 06.09.2021 (Annexure P-3), the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 06.09.2021(Annexure P-3) within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.
