Learned counsel for the petitioner is seeking the concession of interim bail for one week for attending the marriage of his son which is to take place on 13.12.2021 at Hisar. The petitioner, who is a 52 year old man is facing trial in case FIR No.30 dated 31.03.2021 lodged under Sections 376(2)(f) and 376(3) IPC and Sections 6 and 10 of the POCSO Act, registered at Women Police Station, District Hisar for committing rape upon his grand-niece aged just twelve and a half years when the victim's widowed mother had gone out to earn her livelihood.

Learned counsel submits that since he is the father, his presence would be required at the time of the various ceremonies on the occasion of the marriage of his son on 13.12.2021. A prayer has, therefore, been made to grant him interim bail for one week and set aside the order dated 02.12.2021 passed by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Fast Track Special Court, Hisar, vide which the trial Court granted him interim bail for only one day to attend the marriage in

police custody.

Heard and perused the material on record including the impugned order.

This Court is not inclined to extend the concession of interim bail for one week to the petitioner for his son's wedding. The order granting him interim bail for one day in police custody by the trial Court comes across as being reasonable which does not warrant any interference by this Court.

Dismissed.
