Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, the present petition has been filed seeking regular bail as the investigation is already over but as the complainant is yet to be examined, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is not pressing this petition any further but the petitioner prays that the complainant be examined as the first witness in the trial, so that, thereafter, the petitioner can again approach for grant of bail at that stage.
