The petitioner has invoked the writ jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking appropriate writ of mandamus for issuance of directions to the respondents to grant pensionary benefits including pension, gratuity, leave encashment etc. with effect from the date of retirement along with interest @ 18% p.a. under Old Pension Scheme thereby counting the entire daily-wage service of the petitioner followed by regularization as qualifying service in terms of judgment (Annexure P1) as well as to decide the legal notice dated 09.08.2021 (Annexure P-9).

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

Ms. Simran Grewal, Asst. Advocate General, Punjab puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents. Copy of the paper book has been supplied to her.

Upon hearing learned counsel for both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with direction to the official respondents to consider the legal notice dated 09.08.2021 (Annexure P-9), as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioner without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.
